
No, we don't know, Lord," Thomas said. "We have no idea where you are going, so how can we know the way.




Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." — John 14:6 NIV



- "From my perspective, the Holy Spirit is tragically neglected and, for all practical purposes, forgotten. While no evangelical would deny His existence, I'm willing to bet there are millions of churchgoers across
 America who cannot confidently say they have experienced His presence or action in their lives over the past year. And many of them do not believe they can."
- "The world is not moved by love or actions that are of human creation. And the church is not empowered to live differently from any other gathering of people without the Holy Spirit. But when believers live in the power of the Spirit, the evidence in their lives is supernatural. The church cannot help but be different, and the world cannot help but notice."
- "Know that even as you seek to understand the Spirit more, He is so much more and bigger than you will ever be able to grasp. This is not an excuse to stop seeking to know Him, but don't limit Him to what you can learn about Him. The point is not to completely understand God but to worship Him. Let the very fact that you cannot know Him fully lead you to praise Him for His infiniteness and grandeur."

Mysterious Gifts of the Spirit?


