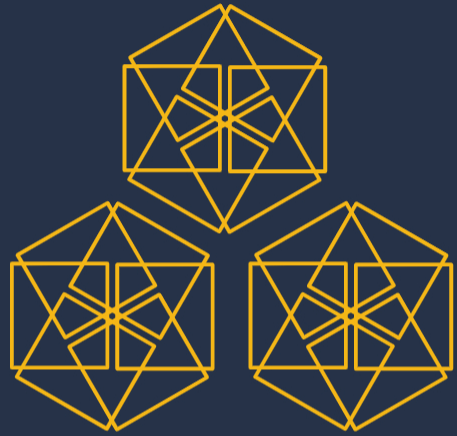

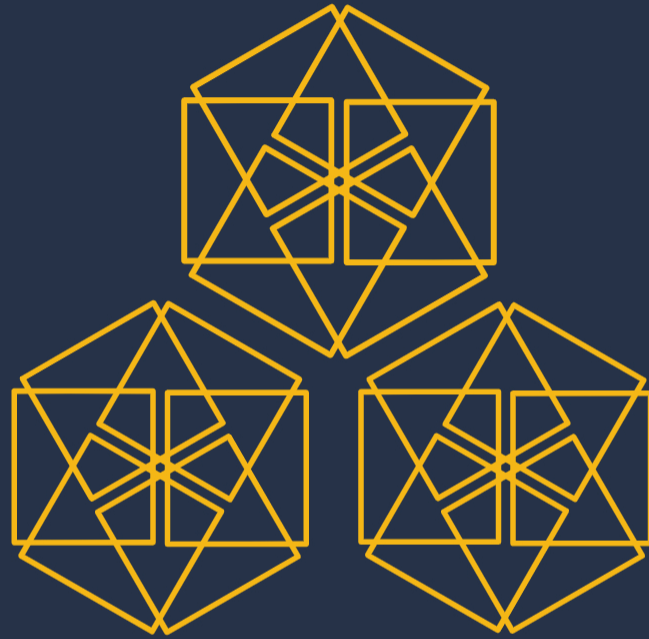

# Characteristics of healthy groups

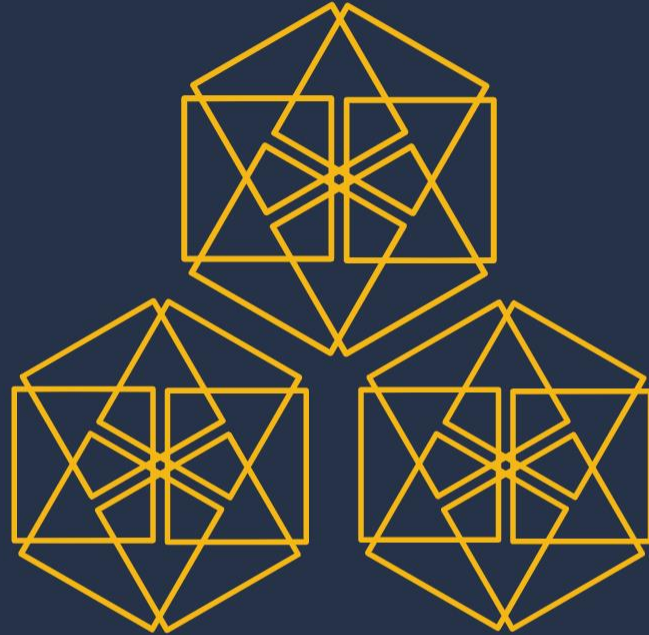
- Grace and Patience
